**PURPOSE:**

The Urban League’s College Readiness (CCR) Scholars Program focuses on college curriculum readiness, degree choices, college application skills, and cultural & financial/financial aid awareness. Students will receive information and career awareness from young professionals in the community, as well as participate in field experiences in some of the surrounding area’s post-secondary institutions such as Valparaiso, Purdue University Northwest, Indiana University Northwest and Ivy Tech.

**OVERVIEW:**

This program runs six (6) weeks per school session. During this time selected students participate in workshops and activities designed for the purpose of educating and encouraging them to stay on-track, with a focus on post-high school goals and college readiness. By the end of the program, students experience measureable progress in their knowledge, behaviors and preparation for college.

**PROGRAM DESIGN:**

**5 weeks of workshops held once per week**

**Ongoing opportunities throughout the program for students to hear from and meet professional mentors sharing and discussing career and educational requirements for success**

**A visit to at least one (1) institution of higher learning/or a mini college fair held at the host school**
