



Woman in Bloom Young Careerist Application

The Women in Bloom Young Careerist Scholarship Application will be awarded annually to one or more young female careerists who demonstrate excellence. The preferred GPA requirement is a 3.25 or higher, but students with a minimum 3.0 GPA are also encouraged to apply. The applicant must submit a written essay detailing how this scholarship will assist them in furthering their career goals. This is open to young female careerists who are attending a two-year, four-year, or professional/technical school. The essay should be no more than one (1) page in length. One or more scholarships starting at two-hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) will be awarded annually based on availability and qualified applicants. Applications should be received *no later* than April 17. Recipients will be notified in early May.

Women in Bloom (WIB) is a not-for-profit organization founded in 2009 to benefit women and young female careerists with their personal and professional development. It is based in Valparaiso, Indiana. The founder, Angela Crossin, along with her former business partner saw a need to address the lack of resources and opportunities for resource-challenged women, young women (ages 14-22), and female veterans.
